

HISTORY OF TOWN POINT PARK

The first owner of the property, then known as Four Farthing Point, was Capt. Thomas Willoughby who acquired it in February 1637. Willoughby sold the site in 1644 to Thomas Watkins, after which it passed into the possession of a series of owners until 1663, when it became the property of Nicholas Wise Sr., a shipwright. Wise's son, also named Nicholas, deeded the point, along with adjoining acreage, to the trustees of Lower Norfolk County in 1682, two years after the locale had been chosen as the site of "Norfolk Towne" by the Virginia Assembly in June 1680.

Before that took place, the point was the location of a "Half Moone" fort also authorized by the Assembly in 1667 to protect the area's tobacco planters from Dutch marauders. All traces of this early fort have long since disappeared. But as late as 1781, when the British occupied the Norfolk area during the Revolutionary War, professional soldiers of Great Britain erected another temporary fort on the same site to protect Norfolk's inner harbor. The "Town Point" promontory has since afforded a spectacular view of some of the country's most historic events. On New Year's Day 1776, the British fleet bombarded the wharves and buildings along the waterfront and set homes afire, sending the entire town up in flames. The hastily rebuilt city was destroyed by fire again in 1804.

Across the harbor during the Civil War, Federal forces burned Portsmouth's Gosport Navy Yard in 1861. The following year came the infamous battle of the Monitor and Merrimac at the mouth of the James River. In the modern era, "Town Point" was transformed from a rundown collection of warehouses and wharves into a beautiful city park, reclaiming its place as the focal point of the Downtown waterfront.



Town Point Park opened in the summer of 1983 as part of a major Downtown revitalization program that included the Waterside Festival Marketplace, a mile long waterfront promenade, a public marina, and improved docks for visiting tall ships and harbor cruise vessels.

The City of Norfolk recognized that Downtown Norfolk and the city landscape had changed considerably since the summer of 1983 and much needed improvements to the Norfolk's premier waterfront park would better serve the community and the guests of Norfolk. In October of 2008, Town Point Park closed her doors to the public to receive an extensive state of the art make-over and reopened Friday, July 3, 2009 for the July 4th weekend, celebrating the 33rd Annual Norfolk Harborfest® and the 27th Annual 4th of July Great American Picnic and Fireworks.

The newly renovated park features a total of seven acres of landscaped walking and jogging paths, and a stress free sanctuary starring the most incredible sunsets ever witnessed. The self-guided trails include the Cannonball Trail, The Elizabeth River Trail and Mermaids on Parade.

Fountains and Public Art: In addition to beautiful landscapes and a magnificent river view, park guests will discover an artful fence running along the Park's edge, depicting "Norfolk Memories", and two fountains.

Military Memorials, Monuments, Museums: Located inside Town Point Park is the Armed Forces Memorial and The Homecoming® statue and within steps of the park, visitors will find Nauticus, the National Maritime Center, the Hampton Roads Naval Museum, located on the second floor of Nauticus, the USS Wisconsin and Lone Sailor Statue®.

Armed Forces Memorial: Located in Town Point Park and on the Elizabeth River, the Armed Forces Memorial in Downtown Norfolk is a moving tribute to the service people in the United States who gave up their lives in war. This memorial is a collection of twenty inscriptions of letters written home by soldiers who lost their lives. The sculpture was dedicated on July 4, 1998.

The Homecoming® Statue: A replica of The Homecoming® statue can be found in Norfolk's Town Point Park. Norfolk is considered the Navy's "hometown," and the city is a perfect place for a Homecoming statue to reside. The statue was placed in Town Point Park on October 14, 2000 in honor of Navy families.

Nauticus, National Maritime Center: Nauticus inspires and educates with engaging & interactive experiences that celebrate connections with today's maritime world. Nauticus is a contemporary museum that uses the natural setting of Norfolk's harbor to showcase global maritime commerce and the world's largest Navy.

USS Wisconsin: The USS Wisconsin is an Iowa-class battleship, the second ship of the United States Navy to be named in honor of the U.S. state of Wisconsin. She was built at the Philadelphia Naval Shipyard in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and launched on 7 December 1943, the second anniversary of the Pearl Harbor raid. The USS Wisconsin was struck from the Naval Vessel Register (NVR) 17 March 2006, and is currently berthed in Whisky Basin, next to Nauticus and steps away from Town Point Park in Downtown Norfolk. She is presently awaiting donation to the City of Norfolk for permanent use as a museum ship.

Lone Sailor Statue®: The Lone Sailor® statue represents the past, present and future Navy bluejacket – adventurous, independent, courageous, self-reliant, and resourceful. His authentic image

evokes the lure and romance of service at sea. The dedication of The Lone Sailor® statue occurred on May 25, 2002 in Norfolk. The statue is on Wisconsin Square facing the bridge of the Battleship USS Wisconsin. Because Norfolk is the home of the U.S. Atlantic Fleet, it serves as a natural home for The Lone Sailor®. The Norfolk statue is surrounded by eight bronze commemorative plaques of Norfolk-based ships and submarines that have met with tragedy - and one plaque



that recalls the 9/11 terrorist attack on the Pentagon. The plaques are USS Cole, USS Forrestal, USS Iowa, USS Liberty, USS Nimitz, USS Newport News, USS Scorpion, and The Pentagon. The Norfolk Lone Sailor®, and its moving site were donated by "Friends of the United States Navy Memorial" - made up of hundreds of individuals and local organizations that pledged their support.



TOWNEBANK FOUNTAIN PARK

TowneBank Fountain Park is located alongside the Waterside Marina and Waterside Live within Town Point Park on the Downtown Norfolk Waterfront. "Fountain Park" offers daily, family oriented activities from Memorial Day through Labor Day, which include an interactive fountain, children's activities, lawn games and more. With eclectic lounge furniture and café bistro seating, TowneBank Fountain Park is a unique location to enjoy the season's days.

The fountain welcomes visitors with the daily operation of 28 water jets shooting water up to 12 feet into the air and enhancing its nighttime effects with color illumination. Please check our website for fountain hours.

OCEAN VIEW BEACH PARK

Norfolk has 125 miles of shoreline with riverfront and bay front views including Ocean View Beach Park on the Chesapeake Bay. This unique 6.5-acre beach park, is considered the jewel of Ocean View.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Accessibility: Town Point Park is fully accessible to individuals with disabilities. All Norfolk Festevents programs are accessible to persons with disabilities, with accessible parking available at all city-parking garages. In Town Point Park, wheelchair-accessible restrooms are located near the Spirit of Norfolk. Individuals requesting special accommodations for events are asked to call the Norfolk Festevents office at 757.441.2345. Special seating accommodations can be requested the day of an event from any event security officer or uniformed staff member.

Photography and Videotaping: Festivals and events are photographed and videotaped for future promotional use by professionals employed by Norfolk Festevents who are easily identified by staff credentials. Festivals and events are also photographed and taped by the news media for television and newspaper coverage and are identified by their press credentials.

DIRECTIONS

By Car: Town Point Park, Norfolk's largest waterfront park, is located on Waterside Drive along the banks of the historic Elizabeth River, and situated between the Waterside Festival Marketplace and Nauticus, The National Maritime Center. From I-64, take 264 West toward Downtown Norfolk and exit left onto Waterside Drive. The park is located approximately ½ mile ahead on the left.

By Light Rail: The Tide extends 7.4 miles from the Eastern Virginia Medical Center complex east through downtown Norfolk and adjacent to I-264 to Newtown Road. Eleven stations provide access to dining, shopping and entertainment as well as the Norfolk State University and Tidewater Community College (Norfolk) campuses. There are four park-and-ride lots where parking is always free. Please visit www.gohrt.com/services/the-tide for complete map and schedule or call 757.222.6100.

By Boat: Town Point Park is located at Mile Marker Zero on the Intracoastal Waterway on the Elizabeth River and is easily accessible by boat. For marina information, call 757.625.3625 or visit watersidemarina.com.

By Ferry: The Elizabeth River ferry runs every 30 minutes 7 days per week. There is one stop in Norfolk at Waterside, and two stops in Portsmouth - at High Street and at North Landing. Monday through Thursday service starts at 7:00AM and ends at 10:00pm, with the last ferry leaving Waterside at 9:45pm. Friday service is 7:00am to Midnight, with the last ferry leaving Waterside at 11:45pm. Saturday service is 10:00am to Midnight with the last ferry leaving Waterside at 11:45pm. Sunday service is 10:00am to 10:00pm with the last ferry leaving Waterside at 9:45pm. Schedules are subject to change based on weather or other events. From Memorial Day to Labor Day, ferries operate every 15 minutes during peak hours Friday through Sunday. Visit www.gohrt.com for more information or call 757-222-6100.

By Water Taxi: The Downtown Water Taxi operates between the Norfolk and Portsmouth Downtown waterfronts Fridays and Saturdays as well as for special events and concerts. Service is seasonal and runs between the hours of 5 pm – 1 am on Friday and Saturday with some extended hours during peak season. Patrons must be at least 21 years of age with a valid photo ID to purchase and/or consume alcoholic beverages.

Lost and Found: Festival attendees can check for lost items with event security or call Norfolk Festevents during business hours, 9am – 5pm, Monday through Friday. Lost persons should report to security at all events. No public address announcements regarding lost persons or items will be made during events.

Restrooms: Portable restrooms, including accessible units for physically impaired, are conveniently located within the park during special events.

We are Virginia Green: Norfolk Festevents, in cooperation with Tidewater Fiber Corp, City of Norfolk, Keep Norfolk Beautiful and Virginia Green, pledges to provide recycling at all events, minimize the use of disposable food service products from our vending partners, use recycled-content printed materials and reduce the amount of waste generated by our events.



TOWN POINT PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- No animals, except hearing/dog animals and service/dog animals, or animals utilized in law enforcement, are permitted in the park, unless otherwise posted.
- No video or photography during performances.
- Use of umbrellas during performances is prohibited.
- Portable tents and tables are not permitted in the park.
- No glass containers may be brought into the park at any time.
- No alcoholic beverages may be brought into the park at any time.
- Persons must be at least 21 years of age with a valid photo ID to purchase and/or consume alcoholic beverages.
- Skates, skateboards and bicycles are not permitted in the park. Bike racks are conveniently located along the perimeter of the park for those biking to events.
- City of Norfolk Codes and Ordinances Sections 25.2 – 60 through Sections 25.2 – 99, govern Town Point Park. For the safety of all, the Norfolk Police may screen persons before entering the park.
- Norfolk Festevents reserves the right to postpone, cancel and/or evacuate events due to adverse weather conditions.
