Time: 11am-6pm daily; Wine sampling ends each day at 4:30pm and wine sales end at 5pm.

Location: Town Point Park, Downtown Norfolk Waterfront, Virginia **Admission:** Ticketed for adults 21 and over, and everyone is welcome

Important Information to Note: A full road closure of Waterside drive will be in effect from Martin's Lane to Main Street. Traffic may be temporarily delayed during the period of the detour set up and activation. The full road closure of Waterside Drive adds to the activation and space of the Wine Festival event. The road closure and traffic interruptions can be expected between Friday, October 14, 2016, at approximately 10:00am until Sunday, October 16, 2016, at approximately 11:45pm.

Picnic spreads and lawn chairs are encouraged in designated areas throughout Town Point Park. Food and beverages will be available for sale during the event. Festevents reserves the right to limit space for individual picnic areas in order to accommodate all patrons and to provide safe access through festival grounds.
