WELCOME TO THE 46TH ANNUAL NORFOLK HARBORFEST

THE HISTORY OF HARBORFEST

It began 43 years ago when the Norwegian Tall Ship Christian Radich came to call on Norfolk, a waterfront community that had no city-owned property on which to dock a ship. The ship was docked three blocks from Town Point at the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and 13,000 people crossed her gangway in just one and a half days. Over the next two years, City planners and leaders created berthing to accommodate more ships, and a waterfront public park was planned. Norfolk Harborfest® was born. Today, tall ships from all over the world frequently call on the City of Norfolk and nearly half a million visitors gather on the downtown waterfront each year for this annual celebration of our region's rich nautical heritage. The traditions of the East Coast's Premier Waterfront Festival are celebrated with nautical history, maritime events, visiting vessels, children's activities, local, regional and national entertainment. Festivities stretch from the Waterside District to the Historic Freemason Harbor.

GENERAL INFORMATION

GUEST RELATIONS

The Harborfest® Guest Relations Center is an all-inclusive guest services station located adjacent to Nauticus. Guest services include lost and found, directions, information, program schedules, and security questions.

LOST & FOUND

Lost and found items can be reported at the Welcome Center adjacent to Nauticus. Parents with lost children are also asked to check in with the Welcome Center or the nearest uniformed police officer. No public address announcements regarding lost persons or items will be made during the event.

FIRST AID

First aid stations are located at both the Waterside and Main Street entrances to Town Point Park.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

For your safety, bikes, skateboards, roller skates, scooters, motorized vehicles of all types, glass bottles and pets (except designated for disability assistance) are not permitted within the festival boundaries. Bicycle racks are available for those wishing to cycle to Harborfest, located at the Main Street entrance and Atlantic Street entrances to Town Point Park.

GUESTS WITH DISABILITIES & THE SENSORY COMFORT ZONE

Harborfest is accessible to persons with disabilities, with parking available at all City parking garages. Wheelchair accessible restrooms are located on-site (at the corner of Boush & Main Streets). Special seating accommodations at all stages can be requested from event security or any uniformed staff member. Town Point Park is in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. New this year, the festival that is designed to overwhelm the senses will be more sensory friendly to those guests who may need a break from all of the activity. Festevents has partnered with national experts KultureCity and will have on-site KultureCity's mobile outreach unit "SAVE". Their sensory activation vehicle, S.A.V.E for short, is designed to bring a mobile sensory experience to any event that lacks a physical space for a dedicated sensory room. PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEOGRAPHY

Festivals and Events are photographed and videotaped for future promotional use by professionals employed by Norfolk Festevents who are easily identified by staff credentials. Festivals and events are also photographed and taped by the news media for television and newspaper coverage and are identified by their press credentials.

DIRECTIONS

By Car: Town Point Park, Norfolk's largest waterfront park, is located on Waterside Drive along the banks of the historic Elizabeth River, and situated between the Waterside Festival Marketplace and Nauticus, the National Maritime Center. From I-64, take I-264 West toward Downtown Norfolk and exit left onto Waterside Drive. The park is located approximately 1/2 mile ahead on the left. Over 19,600 metered and garage parking spaces are conveniently located within walking distance of the park or on the NET bus route.

By Boat: Town Point Park is located at Mile Marker Zero on the Intracoastal Waterway on the Elizabeth River and is easily accessible by boat. Please visit festevents.org or call 757.441.2345 for more information.

By Bicycle: Events in Town Point Park are easily accessible by bike via the Elizabeth River Trail, a biking and pedestrian trail that connects downtown Norfolk to its surrounding areas. There is bike parking at every event, and a bike valet service at select events.

By Light Rail: The Tide Light Rail operates Monday through Thursday, 6:00am to 11:00pm, Friday and Saturday, 6:00am to 12:00 Midnight, and Sunday, 11:00am to 9:00pm. Plan ahead and purchase \$3 tickets online at gohrt.com or use ticket vending machines located at each station.

There are over 19,600 parking spaces in downtown Norfolk within an easy walk to Harborfest. Flat pre-pay rates will be in effect at designated city-owned garages and lots beginning at 4pm on Friday and continuing until 6pm on Sunday.

About The Artist

Luke Stone is an artist and maker that grew up in a many spaces, perhaps for this reason he is fascinated by the journey, process and narrative arch. Mr. Stone began his artistic training and research at the Toledo Museum of Art, the home of the studio glass movement. While enrolled in their intensive programs he practiced photography, metals and found a passion for working with glass. He received a BFA from Virginia Commonwealth University's Craft and Material studies Department with a concentration in glass and metalsmithing. In his craft practice he is investigating the merger of sculptural flame-worked glass into functional objects, with a focus on creating fantasy inspired creatures from folklore. His work can be found in galleries and tobacconists on the East coast and the Midwest. Currently Luke is an instructor at the Governor's School for the Arts where he is one of the lead glass instructors and is expanding his post-bach research in his own studio.
