## Brian Culbertson, Tower of Power Announced as Headliners for 2022 Norfolk Waterfront Jazz Festival presented by Optima Health

**Norfolk, VA** – Smooth jazz superstar Brian Culbertson and the Billboard Jazz chart-topping legends Tower of Power have been announced as headliners for the 39th Annual Norfolk Waterfront Jazz Festival presented by Optima Health on Friday & Saturday, August 26 & 27, 2022, at Town Point Park along the Downtown Norfolk Waterfront.

Culbertson's performance at 9:30pm on Saturday, August 27, will headline day two of the festival, while Tower of Power will headline opening night with a 9:30pm performance on Friday, August 26.

In addition, the duo of Peter White & Vincent Ingala, along with



Pieces of a Dream, have already been announced as performers at the Norfolk Waterfront Jazz Festival, the area's longest-running outdoor jazz festival.

Tickets are currently on sale for the 39th Annual Norfolk Waterfront Jazz Festival presented by Optima Health at <u>bit.ly/FesteventsTix</u>.

Culbertson released his first album, created in his college apartment, "Long Night Out" in 1994. The album took the charts by storm and shot straight to the top which landed him a lengthy record deal. Since his debut, Culbertson has crafted a 20-album catalogue and created more than 30 Billboard No. 1 singles. He is known for his allusiveness of genres and pushing of boundaries to not fit into just one category. Culbertson described his most recent album "XX" as, "a mix of things that I've done throughout my twenty records. There's a lot of funky instrumentals, some popsounding tracks, a couple slow jams, straight-ahead jazz, gospel, some vocals, lots of horns and some straight-up FUNK!"



Tower of Power celebrated their 50th anniversary of the

debut of their first album in 2020. They came together as a group in 1968 in Oakland, California. Throughout their 54 years, they have recorded 18 studio albums and played with Huey Lewis & the News, Elton John, Aerosmith, Bonnie Raitt, Little Feat, Santana, Paula Adbul and Heart just to name a few. In June 2018, their concert at the Fox Theater in Oakland was recorded and released as a live album. This debuted at No. 2 on Billboard's Jazz Contemporary Chart and No. 3 on the Jazz survey. Tower of Power will perform Friday, August 26, 2022, at 9:30pm.
