Boney James, David Sanborn Electric Band Headline 2021 Norfolk Waterfront Jazz Festival Presented by Optima Health

Norfolk, VA – Hampton Roads’ longest-running outdoor jazz festival, the 38th Annual Norfolk Waterfront Jazz Festival presented by Optima Health, returns in grand fashion in 2021 at Town Point Park along the Downtown Norfolk Waterfront. The two-day festival on Friday & Saturday, August 20 & 21, 2021, is headlined by six-time Grammy Award winner David Sanborn and the David Sanborn Electric Band, four-time Grammy-nominated saxophonist Boney James, and many more.



The David Sanborn Electric Band is set to perform on Friday, August 20, at 9:30pm. The Friday bill is rounded out by Jean Carne, Norman Connors and the Starship Orchestra, Marva King, and Lonnie Liston Smith performing as the True Legends of Jazz at 7:30pm, as well as Cindy Bradley and Paula Atherton performing as The Fabulous Blondes at 5:30pm.

Boney James headlines day two of the festival on Saturday, August 21, with a 9:30pm evening performance. Saturday also features performances by Spyro Gyra at 7:30pm and the duo of Adam Hawley and Norfolk native Jackiem Joyner at 5:30pm.

DAVID SANBORN ELECTRIC BAND

One of the most iconic saxophonists for six decades and counting, Sanborn is described by critic Scott Yanow as "the most influential saxophonist on pop, R&B, and crossover players of the past 20 years." Although a jazz musician at heart, Sanborn has transcended genres and musical boundaries throughout his entire career. Sanborn has released 24 albums, won six Grammy Awards and has had eight gold albums and one platinum. Sanborn continues to be one of the most sought-after musicians of his genre.



BONEY JAMES

Now a four-time Grammy nominee with four RIAA Gold records and career sales topping three million units, Boney James continues to defy musical genres; A two time NAACP Award nominee, a Soul Train Award winner and named one of the Top 3 Billboard Contemporary Jazz Artists of the Decade. Solid is the four-time GRAMMY nominated saxophonist's seventeenth album as a leader and will be released by Concord Records, April 17, 2020. Solid follows up his smash 2017 release Honestly which became his eleventh #1 Billboard Contemporary Jazz Album.



JEAN CARNE, NORMAN CONNORS & THE STARSHIP ORCHESTRA, MARVA KING, LONNIE LISTON SMITH (True Legends of Jazz)

The jazz supergroup True Legends of Jazz features drummer Norman Connors & The Starship Orchestra, keyboardist Lonnie Liston Smith, singers Jean Carne and Marva King. Connors has led several influential supergroups and has achieved several huge hits, including "You Are My Starship". Smith, from Richmond, fuses jazz, soul, and funk in his keyboarding style. As prolific vocalists, Carne and King have performed alongside legends such as Stevie Wonder and Michael Jackson.



SPYRO GYRA

Led by saxophonist Jay Beckenstein, Spyro Gyra are one of the most consistently commercially successfully pop-jazz groups to emerge out of the fusion era. As Spyro Gyra looks forward to 2020 and beyond, they show no sign of slowing down. Over the last 40+ years, they have performed over five thousand shows, released thirty-one albums, selling over ten million albums, while also achieving one platinum and two gold albums. Although few acts have accomplished this type of record, they have done it by constantly challenging themselves.



CINDY BRADLEY & PAULA ATHERTON (The Fabulous Blondes)

Trumpeter Cindy Bradley and saxophonist/vocalist Paula Atherton have been a New York City horn powerhouse for years and have now teamed up to become "The Fabulous Blondes." Bradley emerged on the international jazz scene in the mid-to-late 2000s with her debut album, *Just a Little Bit*, in 2007 followed by *Bloom* in 2009, which hit No. 1 on the Billboard Smooth Jazz Chart. Atherton is one of contemporary jazz's most talented saxstresses. Atherton has released a total of five solo albums, including her most recent release, *Shake It*, in 2018.



ADAM HAWLEY & JACKIEM JOYNER

Guitarist Adam Hawley and saxophonist and Norfolk native Jackiem Joyner form a dynamic duo with a groove-oriented style that fuses together contemporary jazz, R&B, gospel, and pop. For over a decade, Hawley worked alongside a bevy of music biggest star's, before launching his solo career in 2016 with his breakthrough album, *Just The Beginning*. Joyner, born in Norfolk in 1980, was introduced to the world by his father, who was a bassist, and surged onto the smooth jazz scene when he signed to Rick Braun's label in 2005.
